From the Airport Frankfurt:

Take the fast train (ICE) in direction to train Station Siegburg. Take the tramline No. 66 (Ramersdorf) to Station "Konrad-Adenauer Platz". Switch over to tramline 62 (Oberkassel Süd) to Station Ramersdorf. From there it's just a 10 minutes' walk to the hotel.

From Siegburg Train Station it's about 15 minutes driving time to the hotel.

- Proof of trainee status
- Presentation of the final report not later than 3 months after the meeting
