Bursaries

The German Division of the IAP and the Vladimir Totović – Foundation provides bursaries to support residents and trainees in pathology from underserved countries. This includes a free registration, 2 nights' accommodation at Hilton Garden Inn Padova City Centre (July 16 – 18, 2026) and travel grants.

Please upload the documents required for the Bursary Application while registering in the course. To apply for bursaries the following items are necessary.

- Submission of a CV and a supporting letter
- A mandatory case presentation
- Submission of an abstract of the case to be presented
- Proof of trainee status
- Presentation of the final report not later than 1 month after the meeting

Only complete application could be considered.

The deadline for applying for a scholarship is **March 1st, 2026**. Applications received after this date cannot be considered.

A decision will be made by the Board of Trustees of the Vladimir Totovic Foundation by **April 12, 2026** and the applicants will be informed thereafter.
