For every resident or (GI-)pathologist looking to expand their knowledge on Barrett's oesophagus (BO), we have developed a concise e-learning module. This Barrett's short course provides practical tools for the assessment of BO biopsies in clinical practice. A short self-assessment test using scrollable slides is provided before and after the module to test yourself and confirm what you have learnt, whereby you will receive interobserver feedback with the gold standard diagnosis after the study period is finished.

Your results from the self-assessment test will be anonymously collected in order to investigate whether following this Barrett's e-learning improves diagnostic consensus of pathologists and residents assessing BO biopsies. 192 Dutch residents and pathologists have already enrolled.

This module was assembled by the Dutch Esophageal Pathology Panel, a national digital review panel for difficult BO biopsies, consisting of 15 expert GI-pathologists that underwent a rigorous quantitative training program, after which they assessed more than 1200 BO review cases to date. Their consensus diagnoses of the cases in the self-assessment test provide the gold standard diagnoses used to calculate the interobserver agreement for each participant.
